CVAD policy- added port accessed in Seidman doesn't have to have needle changed. Discussions surrounding if able to use working lumen when cathflo is instilled in other lumen. More to come, awaiting evidence and understanding but INS standards doesn't recommended. Getting new mediport kits with tented dressing. Working with supply chain. Inpatient will transition first. When Pharmacy mixes non HD drugs in biological safety cabinet still have to mark as hazardous. Will dispense in hazardous bag with bright green label advising to wear one pair of chemo gloves and dispose in yellow bin. Worry about cross contamination. Electrolytes SBAR- commercially premixed potassium and magnesium to be used at all sites. Running on pump, own channel and own line. Sub groups created from all areas to work on Ambulatory Nursing Care and Systemic Cancer Therapy policies. Discussed delaying finalization until we have understanding of how Epic flowsheets are set up. Nurses can change date for non-chemo/bio drugs like feraheme, iron sucrose, zometa and denosumab but provider needs to place communication orders for now. Once order set is updated, the provider can click to allow date changes. Be aware new orders are coming for IVIG that will combined onc and non-onc. </p>		
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
