


Beacon Medication Review

***Note that different icons next to medications indicate different things. A person with a message bubble indicates a patient reported medication. A house icon indicates a medication ordered by an outpatient provider. The pin icon indicates a long term medication.

Once you open the activity you can mark Taking, Taking Differently (enter how they are taking differently), Not Taking (if you select this enter a comment as to why they aren't taking) or Unknown next to each medication(2). If any thing is changed it will highlight it yellow to alert the provider.

Upon completion of review you will document you have reviewed the medication list by clicking Mark as Reviewed (3)
