











Helpful Hints

MAR TAB:

💡 COLOR LEGEND:

- 💡 **NOTE:** You can select **MAR NOTE** (on row next to Title: MAR) and type how a patient likes to take their medications. This note will remain at the top of the MAR screen until you delete it or the patient gets discharged.

HOW TO GIVE MEDICATIONS:

- 💡 Scan the patients' wristband **(this can be done from the BRAIN, PATIENT LIST, or MAR)**.
 - Unlike Allscripts, you do not need to select anything in order to scan the patient.
- 💡 Then you are able to start scanning the patients' individual medications.

HOW TO SEND A MESSAGE TO PHARMACY:

- 💡 Select **RX** in the right corner of the medication itself. This will open up the message pharmacy pop up. Fill out all hard stop information. Then click **SEND**.
- 💡 Similar to Allscripts, you can see when the note was read. There will also be an alert if the pharmacy sends a response.

HOW TO VIEW MORE INFORMATION ABOUT THE MEDICATION:

- 💡 If you select anywhere in the WHITE area around the medication, it will show you: ordered dose, concentration, frequency, route, when it was last given (date/time), which site it was administered thru if via IV site, and have hyperlinks to Lexicomp and Micromedex.

WHAT IF THE SCANNER IS NOT WORKING?

- 💡 Click on **SELECT MEDICATIONS** (on row next to Title: MAR). Then select all the medications that you are administering so that you don't have to click one at a time.
